## DTA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

### Introduction

This document details the terms and conditions for the scholarships available from Designer Training Australia (DTA) for the Certificate IV in Design of Kitchens, Bathrooms and Interior Spaces [MSF40313] for professional members of the Queensland Interior Decorators Association (QIDA).

DTA encourage QIDA Professional Members to apply for a scholarship.

### 1. What is a scholarship?

A scholarship is a financial contribution towards the cost of training. A scholarship cannot be redeemed or claimed as cash and must be used within the terms and conditions of the program. A scholarship is awarded on merit, and all applicants must complete the application form to eligible for selection.

### 2. Eligibility criteria

All applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- ✓ Must be 18 years or older
- ✓ Must not have commenced or completed study with DTA in the course the scholarship application applies
- ✓ Must not be eligible for government funding either directly or via their employer at the time of application
- ✓ Must be a current professional member of QIDA

### 3. Applying for a scholarship

All applications must be provided in writing on the Scholarship Application Form and must be the applicants own views and original work. All fields must be completed and submitted by the due date for the current round.

### 4. The process

All scholarship applications are reviewed by a panel and are judged against the following criteria:

- > Innovation and creative thinking
- > Positivity toward ongoing professional development
- > Enthusiasm and commitment to the industry

Scholarships are awarded based on merit and will only be awarded where the selection panel deems an applicant suitable. All applicants, whether successful or unsuccessful will be notified in writing.

## 5. Scholarship value and payments

The scholarship entitles the recipient to \$2000 as a financial contribution toward the full course in which they applied. The payment is applied directly as a fee credit with DTA against the course cost at time of enrolment and cannot be used in conjunction with any other offer or promotion or be transferred to another enrolment period or entity. Remaining course fees are the responsibility of the recipient and the scholarship credit will be applied after remaining fees have been paid. The recipient is responsible for any additional payments including but not limited to remaining course fees, administration costs, books or resources. Please refer to the general course outline for details of fees and required resources.

## 6. Accepting a scholarship

Scholarship acceptance must be provided in writing and the recipient must adhere to the terms and conditions of the program. By accepting the scholarship, the recipient agrees to become an Ambassador for DTA for the duration of the course and may be asked to participate in marketing activities where reasonably possible.

## 7. Scholarship duration and discontinuation

The scholarship adopts all DTA policies. The scholarship cannot be transferred to another course, enrolment period or other person. The scholarship cannot be deferred or delayed and will be forfeited if not accepted within four weeks of the offer being made. Should the recipient decide to discontinue study, the scholarship will be forfeited and unable to be redeemed on another occasion.

## 8. Marketing and Communications

The recipient of a scholarship must agree to the following marketing and communications activity:

- > Publishing of recipients name, editorial and general promotional activities
- > Sharing of the recipient's details with QIDA. Participation in promotional activities where reasonably possible.
